My thirst for exploration and an experimental way of working was nurtured at Middlesex university where I studied applied arts, creating in metal, paper, textiles and ceramics. With an ambition to learn more about precious metals, I undertook a year's residency at the prestigious <u>Bishopsland workshops</u> in Oxfordshire in 2012, during which I was awarded accolades, such as a bursary from the Goldsmith's Company, a prize for gold jewellery design from Jacqueline Mina OBE and also exhibited a hand engraved, raised and chased dish at the V&A Museum.

In 2014 an artist in residence position at South Hill Park, Berkshire, gave me the opportunity to share my skills teaching jewellery and silversmithing to adults. The residency also gave me the freedom to experiment further, with methods of casting and surface decoration, which served to further enrich my growing collection of work.

I recently moved to the wonderful making community at <u>Cockpit Arts, Holborn</u>, where I undertake bespoke commissions and create one-off pieces, as well as limited edition ranges. I also make jewellery and boxes for the jeweller <u>Romilly-Saumarez Smith.</u>
